

Surfaces

Polished or laminated surfaces should be cleaned using a damp cloth and buffed with a dry duster. Polished surfaces are heat resistant, but will require a protector when using direct heat items.

Fabric

Upholstery cover stains can normally be treated with a damp cloth provided they are treated immediately. Some fabrics may require specialist cleaning. If a cleaning substance is used it should be tested on a non-visible area to check it does not damage the fabric.

Leather

For regular cleaning, simply vacuum and then use a soft cloth and wring it out in a warm mild soap solution, NEVER DETERGENT. Wipe the leather using a light circular motion taking care not to soak the leather. Repeat using clean water. A Leather Cleaning kit is available to purchase from Classic Furniture comprising a cleaner, Ink Remover and Rejuvenator.

Stacking Chairs & Tables

When chairs / tables are designed to stack please take care not to create a safety issue by stacking the chairs / tables too high. We recommend a maximum number of 4 to 6 dependent on the size and weight of the chairs or tables.

When moving stacks of chairs or tables we recommend a trolley should be used.

CHAIRS AND TABLES SHOULD NEVER BE DRAGGED AS THIS MAY DAMAGE THE FURNITURE.

Folding Tables

The folding tables we supply are designed for easy storage when not in use.

Positioning and opening a table

When moving the table ensure the tabletop is locked in the vertical position. Move the table into position preferably using a trolley and then manually (refer to your company manual handling policy) lift the table from the trolley into its final position. Release the table from the vertical position and carefully lower the top to the horizontal position and ensure the tabletop is locked into position before use. **DO NOT DRAG THE TABLE, AS IT WILL DAMAGE THE FOLDING MECHANISM.**

Closing the table and moving the table to storage

Close the tabletop from its horizontal position by releasing the lock and carefully raise the tabletop to the vertical position and ensure it locks into position. The table is then ready to be moved as previously described.

Periodic Maintenance Of Furniture

All furniture should be periodically checked for any loose bolts, screws or fixings. We recommend this check be completed more frequently on all outdoor furniture and in high usage indoor environments.

Care Of Outdoor Furniture

We recommend that exposed timber on outdoor furniture be treated with suitable wood oil on a regular basis to give the furniture a longer life and maintain its appearance. Classic Furniture sells an Outdoor Furniture Maintenance Kit that contains all the necessary products.
